Cancer Awareness Talk

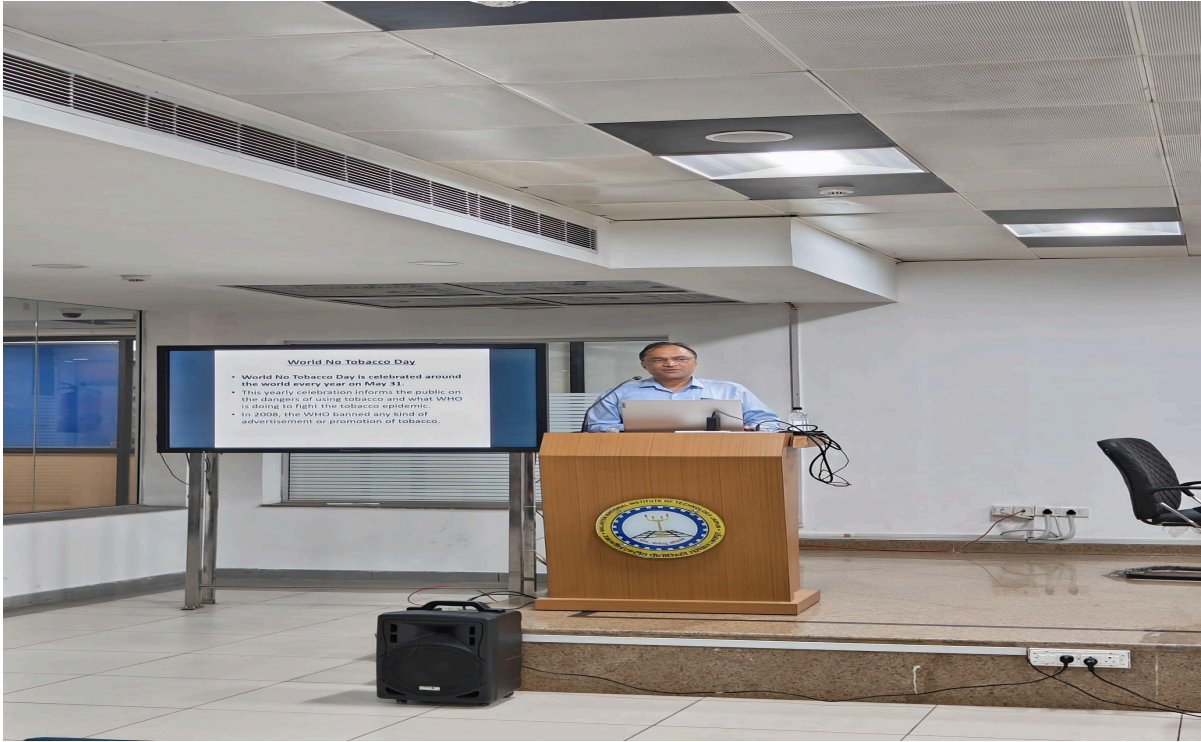


About :

This event was held at Malaviya Sabhagar, MNIT Jaipur, from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM. The talk was led by **Dr. Dinesh Gupta, Senior Consultant Oncosurgeon at Shalby Multispeciality Hospital, Jaipur**. The session delved into the harmful effects of tobacco, the causes of cancer, and preventive measures. This initiative was undertaken in compliance with the **Ministry of Education's** directives on **Tobacco-Free Educational Institutions (ToFEI)**. Currently, Dr. Gupta serves as a Senior Consultant Oncosurgeon at Shalby Multispeciality Hospital in Vaishali Nagar, Jaipur.
